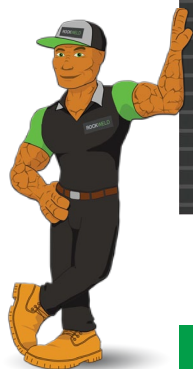

## RAH Aboriginal Garden Wall

The 52m long Gabion wall we installed at the new Royal Adelaide Hospital development is now complete. Laser cut Corten panels incorporating an Aboriginal design pattern have been placed along the top of the wall, creating a sheltered, quiet space for patients and visitors. It is certainly going to be an impressive landmark feature, visible from a major intersection in Adelaide. Congratulations to all our guys on this project for a fantastic job!



## Wellington Lodge River Gabions

A cattle farmer from Wellington needed a suitable barrier to stop debris from fallen branches and silt, accumulating around the pump inlets that bring water to the livestock on his farm. Prospect Contractors installed Gabions around the pumping area to solve this ongoing problem. Gabions are an ideal solution in any aquatic situation, as they are permeable, flexible and environmentally friendly!



## Seaford Meadows Swale Drain

Prospect Contractors installed Gabions and Renos in a swale drain at Seaford Meadows, which will take storm water from the new subdivision to the Onkaparinga River.





## Torrens Park Creek Gabions

An owner of a home in Torrens Park, contacted us to install Gabions to their severely eroded creek bed. They could see the benefit of Gabions in erosion control, as we installed Gabions to their neighbours property several years ago.

We also helped to install a footbridge, to enable the owners to access their land on the other side of the creek.



## Carrickalinga Retaining Walls

Prospect Contractors were asked by the owners of a home at Carrickalinga, for a cost effective way to tidy up around their house. Gabions were installed at the front of the house to help hide and reinforce an existing concrete wall.

We also excavated into the bank at the rear of the house, to help create a new driveway to the back shed.



## Hillbank Stepped Gabion Wall

Centina contacted Prospect Contractors for an erosion control solution to a corner of a new block. Three levels of stepped Gabions were installed to achieve this.





## Seacliff Community Centre

Prospect Contractors have been subcontracted by BMD to install two Gabion walls, approximately 800m<sup>3</sup> in total, at the new Kauri Parade Community & Sporting Precinct. There will be a large wall surrounding a section of the new tennis courts and also another around the new central building which will incorporate a music centre as well as sporting and recreational clubs that currently use the existing facilities.



## The Square at Woodville West

The Square at Woodville West is a new housing development where we are installing multiple Gabion walls in a reserve, adjacent to the Grange railway line.

The new neighbourhood is designed around a series of connected parks, gardens, walking tracks and paths, incorporating our Gabions. The new development will create a contemporary, vibrant and sustainable housing area close to the city of Adelaide.





## Kingston Crescent Fence

We recently installed a hand faced sandstone Rockweld fence at a new home at Kingston Park. The home owner is extremely happy with the end result emailing us this wonderful review:

## Largs Bay Wall and Seating

## Aberfoyle Park Fence

Prospect Contractors replaced a section of brush fence at a local home with a low, free standing Rockweld wall. The wall will incorporate timber slats to the top of the wall, which will provide privacy and become a feature fence in the neighbourhood.



## McCracken Seat

The owners of a home in McCracken were landscaping their back yard and required a 1m high retaining wall to create a split level to their garden. After gaining access through a side fence, Prospect Contractors were able to create a practical and stylish retaining wall, incorporating a corner seat.



## Tennis Court Retaining Wall

We recently installed a low retaining wall around an existing tennis court at a home in Parracombe.
